IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION

Meriday is so excited to let you know about a stipend we received to benefit our infant and toddler programs.

When we think of curriculum we often think preschoolers and neglect to think about our infants and toddlers. Our goal is to create a high-quality program for infants and toddlers with emphasis on defining areas in the room for separate areas for sleeping, playing, eating, and changing diapers.

Our goal for this room will be to create more space to enhance the health and safety for additional crawling space and to create multiple spaces in the room to include stimulating sensory areas to include textured wall and surfaces, mirrors, tactile play stations and fun lighting and sounds. We plan to have a designated "tummy time" space, a "cozy corner" with soft books, soft baby dolls and stuffed puppets and more. Overall we envision an atmosphere of real play-based learning with our infant program which will include intentional sensory play, interactive games, music and movement, hands on learning and a language-rich environment.

So if that all sounds like a big undertaking you would be correct and we hope to accomplish it with as little interruption as possible!

Beginning after hours on December 4th we will be taking down the wall between the current infant room and the empty room next door. The majority of the scope of work will be done over the weekend of December 6th and 7th. Some work will be done on Friday the 5th. During this process we will relocate the infants to our toddler room area room #E101-C. We anticipate that this will only be for one day.

It is our goal to provide as little interruption to our daily programing as possible while maintaining the safety and integrity of our services to you and your family. If you have any questions, please reach out to the office and we will do our best to answers any questions you may have.
